ANZAMEMS Life Member Award

Conditions of entry:

Selection Criteria

Nominees for the ANZAMEMS Life Member Award:

- Should have made an outstanding and sustained contribution to the Association or its objects in at least two of the following categories: leadership, scholarship, teaching, mentorship, or service.
- Should have made a positive impact on the field at the national and/or international level, reaching what is generally acknowledged as the top of their profession.

Eligibility

Nominees for the ANZAMEMS Life Member Award:

- Should be permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand and have been resident in either country for a significant portion of their career.
- Need not have a university affiliation.

Nomination Letter and Supporting Materials

Each nomination should be supported by a letter of nomination, the nominee's resume, and up to five letters of recommendation (including that of the nominator) that speak to the nominee's distinction in the identified categories.

Please note that the letter of nomination and one letter of recommendation must come from a current financial member of ANZAMEMS.

1) Letter of Nomination

The letter of nomination should include the name and affiliation (if relevant) of the nominee; the name, and affiliation of the nominator; the names of the authors of letters of recommendation; and contact information for all parties. The letter of nomination should lay out the reasons for the nomination.

2) Resume

The nominee, or the nominator on behalf of the nominee, should submit a standard academic CV detailing education, work experience, scholarship, and, if relevant, service to Parergon or on the ANZAMEMS' Committee.

3) Letters of Recommendation

One or more of the categories (leadership, scholarship, teaching, mentorship, or service) should be addressed in each of the letters of recommendation. The letters should focus on the distinction of the nominee's whole career.

Number of Awards

The ANZAMEMS Life Member Award may be made no more than once every four years.

Selection of Awardees

The Committee will select the most outstanding nominee from the received nominations. A Special Resolution to award Life Membership to the Committee's nominee will then be moved at an Annual General Meeting, or a specially convened General Meeting, to be voted on by the membership. The motion will require a 75% majority of the voting membership present at that meeting to be considered passed. The Committee, however, reserves the right to not make a recommendation for a Life Member Award to the AGM/GM, if no nominations are received, or if it is deemed that there is no sufficiently outstanding candidate among those that are.

Award

The awardee will receive an ANZAMEMS honorary membership, to begin at the start of the following financial year. If convenient, the Award may be presented at an ANZAMEMS conference.
